Current Programs We Offer

Here is an outline of what programs we have to offer currently. We do plan on adding more, so we will update you in future newsletters. So keep watching!!!

- Memorial Quilt Program - A personalized quilt, hand made by our quilt maker volunteer to help you remember your angel(s) by. A \$20.00 fee covers materials as well as shipping costs.
- Angelversary Program - If you choose to sign up for this program, on your angel's birthday, we will either send you a card or e-card to remind you that we are thinking about you during this emotional time, as well as a way to

celebrate your angel being born to heaven.

E-Mail Buddy –

When you become an angel mommy, the hardest thing to do is to talk or listen about your loss or other's losses. But with this program a new or currently grieving mommy is paired up with a mommy who has experienced your grief. It gives that mommy the opportunity to talk, on your terms, as well as give someone a shoulder to cry on.

• Daddy Program – If your husband feels kind of distant, distraught, or left out of the picture, He is not alone. A lot of angel daddies are left out of the grieving process too. Not anymore.

Vice President Sean Green has a program for them. Whether it's just to talk or listen to or tell a story about his experiences. Remember, Daddies are never alone. Contact Sean for more info. • Warm Fuzzy Program – In conjunction with the Hugs for Hope Foundation, this program will have you write to sick children, so you are able to make them feel a little better, while they are getting better.
